CAA School Safety Patrollers personally benefit from the responsibilities they are given. Some of our Patrollers have even won life-saving medals and other awards for their dedication. Participation in the CAA School Safety Patrol program is voluntary and typically open to students 11 – 14 years of age. As your child wants to be a Patroller, we are confident in their positive contribution to this community legacy program.

We expect Patrollers to take their responsibility seriously. Patrollers volunteer about 15 minutes of their time for each scheduled shift and are trained to never step onto the road while on duty. Patrol team members are chosen by school officials for their dependability, attitude, knowledge and interest in helping others. Their primary responsibility as traffic safety ambassadors at their school include:

- Modelling safe road and safe school bus practices
- Helping students arrive to and from school safely – on school buses or near school crossings
- Displaying leadership qualities and good citizenship
